## STARCK BY WARENDORF:

### “Library” kitchen in Classic material combination



The “Library” is the antithesis of the traditional kitchen with its wrap-around book shelves and bookish ladder which glides on a profile around the front of the projecting central block. Philippe Starck’s intention is to combine culture and food in the domestic kitchen. The niche is clad in chrome with a matching chrome profile. Visually, this connects it to the chrome trumpet feet on the functional table.

This kitchen and its sophisticated material mix consisting of fine-grained cherry mahogany and stainless steel is complemented by a selection of different functional tables – a dining table with illuminated marble top, a working table with integrated sink and adjoining hob. This arrangement makes it easy to clean the hob by rinsing it with the spray tap. The twin chrome trumpet feet supporting the functional tables are a defining touch from designer Philippe Starck.
